Stricken ship: Efforts on to plug oil spill

Dutch shipwreck salvage firm Smit was working on the bow of the *Concordia* on Tuesday, making preparations to remove the fuel.

They were at work as divers

located another body from the wreckage, bringing the death toll to 16.

Officials have identified an initial six tanks that will be tapped, located in a relatively easy-to-reach area of the ship. Franco Gabrielli, head of the national civil protection agency, told reporters Tuesday that once the tanks are emptied, 50 per cent of the fuel aboard the ship will have been extracted.

The pumping will continue 24 hours a day barring rough seas or technical glitches in this initial phase, he said.

"This is a complicated operation," Gabrielli said. Smit has estimated the extraction operation could last a month. The *Concordia* ran aground and capsized off the Tuscan island of Giglio on January 13 after the captain veered from his approved course and gashed the ship's hull on a reef, forcing the panicked evacuation of 4,200 passengers and crew.
