

In collaboration with a local system integrator and the TNHRNC, CP PLUS installed 330 cameras across 17 temples in Kumbakonam – 300 3MP bullet cameras and 30 2MP IP PTZ cameras, and an NVR to centrally monitor all the locations from the control room. On the successful
